Thank you for purchasing the StudioCentral™ Library Windows® client Version 3.0 [SGI mktg code: SC4-SCWINCL-3.0]. The Windows 3.0 client is one of two native clients available for use with StudioCentral 3.x. The second native client is the Macintosh® client Version 3.0 [SGI mktg code: SC4-SCMACCL-3.0], which is available separately.

The Windows 3.0 client CD installs on your server running StudioCentral 3.0 and above and enables that server to distribute unlimited native Windows clients. The StudioCentral client will function on any Microsoft Windows NT machine.

New features for the Windows client include:

- Completely redesigned user interface that better utilizes server features, including selection of information fields to display in browser
- Catalog and Get Info window functionality now included in one window
- Quick Start window displayed upon log-in
- Access to repositories other than the default repository without reconfiguration
- Support for checkin/retrieval of folder hierarchy
- Show folders that an asset is contained in and show internal version name for an asset
- Ability to set access control on assets for individual users and groups and set default access settings
- Support for selecting multiple assets in StudioCentral browser for applying same operation
- Batch checkin which supports adding the same metadata to all assets being checked within a batch operation
- New Delete and Remove options for folders and assets and ability to copy/paste assets between folders
- Start StudioCentral automatically when starting Windows
- Ability to assign default datamodels to be added to all assets
